Highlights Of Rules For Scorekeepers

Scoring:

Correct Answer to Regular and Toss-up Question 20 Pts.

Correct Answer to Free Question 10 Pts.

Incorrect Answer to Question #1 to 14 -0 Pts.

Incorrect Answer to Regular and Toss-up Question 15 to end 10 Pts.

Incorrect Answer to any Free Question -0 Pts.

Team accumulates 2 fouls -10 Pts.

Team score may be negative

Freezing:

A quizzer who answers three 20-pt. Questions freezes the top chair available. He may answer only toss-up and free questions. If removed from a quiz, he may not return.

Position Win:

Occurs when a team captures the top 3 chairs after question number 5. This ends the quiz and gives that team 4 game points.

Ties:

In case of tie, one "Sudden Death" question is given. Either that question or the free question must be answered correctly to end quiz.

Challenge Question:

May be called for after the 5th question and through the 12th question. Question # 13 may be a challenge question.

Fouls:

Verbal communications after "Question" is called Touching chair after "Question" is called Jumping after "Question" is called but before Question begins Hand motion or sign other than the following:

- Keep Moving because time is running out
- Contest
- Time Out
- Sign indicating quizzers to "Speed up" or "Slow Down" in jumping
